(Fishers, Indiana) - The Fishers Police Department is investigating an armed robbery that occurred at approximately 10:30am at the First Merchants Bank, located at 12514 E 116th Street in Fishers. According to witnesses a male entered the bank and approached a female teller. The suspect displayed a black handgun and demanded money. After obtaining an undetermined amount of cash the suspect ran southbound from the bank.

On January 16, 2009 at approximately 10:36am Dispatch received a bank alarm from the First Merchants Bank, located at 12514 E 116th Street in Fishers. Bank officials advised a male, wearing a black hooded coat and ski mask, entered the bank and walked directly up to a female teller. The suspect displayed a black handgun and demanded money from two registers. Once the suspect obtained an undetermined amount of cash he exited the bank and ran southbound across 116th Street into a neighborhood.

An alert witness observed the suspect running from the bank. This witness followed the suspect and observed him enter a green Camaro passenger car. The witness observed the suspect exit the Camaro and throw a pair of shoes in a nearby dumpster. The witness relayed the information to Dispatch.

Several officers were in the area and began searching for the green Camaro. Officer Reginald Jackson located the Camaro traveling southbound on Fall Creek Road. The Camaro stopped near the intersection of 79th Street. The lone driver was taken into custody without incident. The suspect and suspect vehicle were transported to the Fishers Police Department.
