(Fishers, Indiana) - The Fishers Police Department is investigating a shooting that occurred near 6018 South Bay Drive in Fishers. Officers were called to the area on Wednesday, February 25th at approximately 10:20 pm.

Officers arrived to find a male victim lying outside the residence. The victim had been shot in the right foot and right arm. Fishers Fire Department personnel treated the victim on the scene and transported him to Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis. Officers secured the scene and separated witnesses. Several people were also detained at that time.

The victim reported that he was going to visit a friend at 6018 South Bay Drive. As he arrived, a light colored car pulled in behind him. As he walked toward the residence two men approached him demanding money. One of the suspects was armed with a shotgun and the other displayed a handgun. During this confrontation the victim was shot in the foot and arm. Several other rounds were fired striking the residence at 6018 and 6014. The suspects fled the area in the light colored car and have not been located.

Aaron Easton was driving away from the area when the first officers arrived. Easton was arrested for possession of marijuana. Frank Bohannon was with the victim when officers arrived. Bohannon was arrested for possession of cocaine.

The people detained in connection with the shooting, including the victim, were not cooperative and did not provide much information about the incident. Investigators recovered shell casings from two weapons. No weapons have been recovered. The investigation is ongoing.
