(Fishers, Indiana) - The Fishers Police Department is investigating a robbery that occurred at the CVS, 10580 E. 96<sup>th</sup> Street in Fishers. The robbery occurred on Sunday, March 9<sup>th</sup> at approximately 7:20 am. A male suspect entered the store, confronted two employees and took an undetermined amount of cash.

A store employee told investigators that the suspect entered the store wearing all black clothing. The suspect confronted both employees in the front of the store. The suspect forced the two employees into a store office. The suspect took an undetermined amount of cash. The suspect forced both employees to lie on the ground and left the store. Neither employee was hurt during the robbery.
