(Fishers, Indiana) - The Fishers Police Department arrested Joshua Lindsey on Saturday, March 29<sup>th</sup> and charged him with armed robbery. The robbery occurred at the CVS Pharmacy Store, 8295 E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street in Fishers.

Investigators from the Fishers Police Department were conducting surveillance of local CVS Stores in response to a series of robberies on the north side of Indianapolis. Two of the robberies occurred in Fishers earlier this year. Investigators observed Lindsey, dressed in all black clothing, run across the parking and into the CVS Store. Investigators reported the robbery in progress and other police units responded. Lindsey completed the robbery and fled from the store. Officers chased Lindsey as he ran south from the store. Lindsey was caught and taken into custody without incident. Officers recovered cash, a black BB gun and a can of pepper spray.

Two employees were working in the CVS when Lindsey entered at approximately 9:45 pm. Lindsey pointed the handgun at a female employee and escorted her to the store office. The second store employee was in the office as Lindsey entered. Lindsey forced both employees to lie on the floor as he collected cash. Neither employee was physically injured during the robbery.

Investigators interviewed Lindsey at the Fishers Police Department. Lindsey has not admitted to any involvement in other area robberies. The investigation is ongoing.
