CRIME WATCH INFORMATION

May 9, 2008

The Fishers Police Department is investigating a home invasion that occurred at approximately 5:00 am on Wednesday, May 7, 2008. Officers responded to Courage Crossing in the Brooks Chase sub-division (131st and Brooks School Road) after the homeowner reported finding a man in the master bedroom. Officers responded to the area but did not locate the man.

The homeowner reported that she was the first to wake up and see a man crawling on the floor of their bedroom. She immediately woke her husband who attempted to grab the man but he was unable to hold him. The suspect ran out the front door of the residence. The homeowner chased the man west towards Brooks School Road but was not able to catch him. The only description of the suspect is that he is a short, skinny male.
