**(Fishers, Indiana) Fishers Police Investigate a Reported Rape over Weekend**

At approximately 2:30am on Sunday, 5/9/2010, a female homeowner reported that a male had just entered her home and raped her at knife point. Officers responded to the victim's home located within the Brookston Place neighborhood near the intersection of Brooks School Road and Fall Creek Road. The homeowner told officers that she was awakened by a younger black male in her bedroom. She said the male raped her while holding a knife at her neck.

Immediately after the attack the suspect stole certain items from the victim after demanding the specific items from her. The homeowner said she complied with the male's demand and gave him the items. She said the suspect then fled the home.

The suspect was described as a younger, slender black male, approximately 5'5" tall, wearing a hooded sweatshirt. The investigation revealed that the suspect likely made entry into the home through an unlocked garage service door. Detectives are advising that it is possible that the suspect fled the area on a bicycle due to what appeared to be fresh tracks located in the homeowner's yard.

Detective Sergeant Luke Gannon is asking anyone who may have seen anyone matching the suspect's description in the area to call immediately with information.
