(Fishers, Indiana) – The Fishers Police Criminal Investigations Division clears a recent residential burglary case by warrant service.

On the evening of June 10<sup>th</sup>, 18 year old Fishers resident Duane Devo Parker arrived at the police station to turn himself in after being told by family members that Fishers Detectives had arrived at his residence earlier to serve a warrant against him.

The warrant included one count of Burglary (a Class B Felony) and a count of Theft (a Class D Felony). The case involved a residential burglary which occurred on October 3, 2008 at a Fishers residence located in the Brooks Chase subdivision. During that burglary several items of personal property were stolen from the home and some of the mentioned items were later recovered as a result of a search of Parker's residence.

The Fishers Police Criminal Investigations Division is further investigating Parker to determine possible involvement in separate area burglaries and thefts.
