(Fishers, Indiana) - With the July 4th Holiday quickly approaching the Fishers Police Department wants everyone to be reminded of the Indiana State Law regarding the usage of fireworks.

Fireworks Law Provisions:

- Fireworks may only be used on the user's property; or on the property of someone who has consented to the use of fireworks; or at a special discharge location. For example, the debris from airborne fireworks must remain on the property of the consenting party.
- Fireworks can be purchased only by persons 18 years of age or older and children may possess or use any kind of firework only when an adult is present.
- Penalties for violating the fireworks law can range from a Class A misdemeanor up to a Class C felony in the case of the reckless or intentional use of fireworks that result in a person's death.
- On Memorial Day, the 4th of July, Labor Day and New Year's Eve fireworks may be discharged from 9 a.m. to midnight. Any other day of the year fireworks may be discharged from 9 a.m. to 11 p.m.
