The "**No Door to Door Solicitation**" stickers are ready! Anyone interested in obtaining a sticker can come to the Fishers Police Department, Monday through Friday between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm. **Each person may pick up 20 stickers at a time.** The stickers should be handed out to homeowners that will post the sticker on their home. We recommend that stickers are placed by the front door near the doorbell in a conspicuous location. Visibility from the street is preferred if possible.

The police department is also investigating to following crimes. An arrest was made in Delaware Crossing after an alert homeowner called police. Please continue to practice home safety and lock doors and windows. Leave exterior lights on, remove valuables and lock cars parked outside.

Delaware Crossing – June 30, 2008

The Fishers Police Department responded to Bay Lane when an alert homeowner called police to report three juveniles in the area looking in parked cars. Officers arrived and located two of the three as they ran from the area. All three were located and arrested. Two were 18 years old and one was a 17 year old juvenile.

Hawks Landing at Gray Eagle – June 28, 2008

The Fishers Police Department is investigating a theft at a residence on Hawks Landing Drive. The homeowner reported that they found their garage door open and a purse missing from the car parked in the garage. The garage door had been closed earlier in the evening. The homeowner told investigators that a contractor had recently done some work on the home. The suspects attempted to use credit cards immediately following the theft. The investigation is ongoing.

The suspect(s) used the garage door opener to access the garage. The suspect(s) took a television from the garage and a set of tools. The homeowner also reported that the suspect(s) pulled the attic access ladder down and may have entered the attic.

Sunblest Homes – June 24, 2008

The Fishers Police Department is investigating a theft from vehicle that occurred on Kenetta Court. The suspect(s) entered and unlocked vehicle parked in the driveway and used the garage door opener to access the garage.
