(Fishers, Indiana) - The Fishers Police Department is investigating a robbery that occurred on Tuesday, July 15th at approximately 9:30 pm. The robbery occurred at the Stop and Go Tan, 8690 East 96th Street in Fishers. The suspect entered the store, displayed a knife and took an undetermined amount of cash.

The victim/employee stated that the suspect first came into the store at approximately 9:00 pm. The man requested information about tanning packages and exited the store. He returned fifteen minutes later to purchase a tanning package. As the employee was preparing to enter the suspect's information into the computer, the suspect confronted the victim/employee with a knife and demanded money from the cash register. The suspect opened the cash register and took an undetermined amount of cash. The suspect left the store and got into a green pickup truck driven by a female.

No one was injured during the robbery. There were two customers in the business when the robbery occurred but they had no knowledge of the robbery. Anyone with information is asked to call the Fishers Police Department, 595-3328. The investigation is ongoing.
