(Fishers, Indiana) - The Fishers Police Department is investigating a burglary that occurred early Sunday morning in the 13200 Block of Patriotic Way in the Brooks Chase sub-division (131st and Brooks School Road).

Officers were in the area checking for a suspicious person after a homeowner on Loyalty Drive reported that someone rang his doorbell at 3:00 am but ran away as he got up to answer the door. The suspicious person was described as wearing all dark clothing with a dark colored backpack. Officers located a 13 year old juvenile on Republic Drive in Brooks Chase. The 13 year old juvenile was detained and transported to the Fishers Police Department.

As officers were searching the area, a homeowner on Patriotic Way reported a burglary at his residence. A back window on the home had been smashed and the house ransacked. The homeowner reported several items missing from his home.

Officers responded to the home of the 13 year old juvenile and recovered property from the Patriotic Way burglary. Officers arrested a second juvenile male during the investigation. Officers continue to investigate other residential burglaries in the Fishers area. The investigation is ongoing.
