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FISHERS POLICE INVESTIGATE 96TH STREET ARMED ROBBERY

(Fishers, Indiana) – On December 23, 2010 at 4:35am, Fishers Police responded to a dispatched report of an armed robbery at the Circle K gas station located at the intersection of 96th and Allisonville Road. The attendant told arriving officers that a young adult male wearing all black clothing (including mask and gloves) entered the business and immediately displayed a dark colored handgun demanding cash. The teller said he complied and handed the suspect an undisclosed amount of cash from his register.

The suspect then fled on foot to the north toward the adjacent South Bay Condominiums. Carmel Police assisted Fishers PD with a perimeter search and K-9 tracking. The K-9 tracked north into the mentioned condos until it abruptly stopped leading officers to believe that the suspect may have entered a vehicle at that point.

The suspect is further described as black male, approximately 5'10" tall weighing approximately 150 lbs. Although it has been several weeks since Fishers experienced its latest armed robbery, the description and method of this robbery tend to match that of the string of armed robberies that occurred in October.
